**Competition level:**

Interclub Competition (ISU Rule 107.12.) for Juniors and Youngsters. The Juniors and Youngsters categories (single skating) except categories chicks are associated with the European Criterium Tournaments 2007/2008. The results of the participating teams will count towards the competition of the International Trophy of Figure Skating, organized by the Italian National Sport League U.I.S.P.

**Entries:**

All clubs, which are members of National Figure Skating Federations associated with the I.S.U., are invited to take part in the competition. Each club may enter 2 competitors in each category (2 males and 2 females). The organizing club reserves the right to enter more competitors. **In case of too many entries, the organizer reserves the right to limit the number of participants.**

**Deadline for entries:**

The entries (competitors, judges, teamleaders, coaches, other persons) **must reach** the organizer by **December 12, 2008** at the following address:

### **Charges:**

€ (EURO) 35,- have to be paid for each competitor at the registration before the competition.

### **Expenses:**

The organizer does not pay for any expenses of the teams. The hotel accommodation (Austria Trend Hotel Donauzentrum) and full board for referees, judges and members of the Technical Panels on duty, which are not residents of Vienna, will be arranged and paid by the organizer from dinner, January 12, 2009 until lunch, January 16, 2008.

### **Judges:**

Each club, which has entries in at least two categories, can enter one International Judge or Judge for I.S.U. Championships. In case of too many entries, panels of judges will be drawn on December 20, 2008. Afterwards a written confirmation will be sent to each club.

### **Responsibility:**

In accordance with I.S.U. Regulations, rule 119, all participants, officials and volunteers act at their own responsibility. The organizer will provide medical emergency aid during the competition.

### **Music:**

Music will be reproduced from a CD-player. CD's must have the full name of the competitor, club and category in which the competitor is entered. CD's must be handed over to the organizer immediately after the arrival of the teams.

### **Calculation of results:**

According to ISU Rule 107, paragraph 12, the competition and the calculation of the results will be conducted in accordance with the regulations of the Austrian Figure Skating Federation (principle of majority - former OBO system). The ISU Judging System will be used in Categories Junior and Novice.

### **Planned Program Content Sheet:**

**It is mandatory that the form "Planned Program Content Sheet" must be filled in for each skater of categories Junior and Novice in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication. This form must reach the organizer at latest December 20, 2008. If possible by E-mail ([sieber.eke@aon.at](mailto:sieber.eke@aon.at)) or by Fax: +43 1 8049391.**

### **Awards:**

The three best-placed competitors of each event will get special presents, the others diplomas.

### **Hellmut-Seibt-Badges and Prize Money:**

The winners (1 female and 1 male) of the Junior categories are at the same time the winners of the **Hellmut-Seibt-Badges**. **Each winner of the badge will get a Prize Money of € 300,- (EURO)**. The winner of the two Novice Girls categories ('93 and '94) with the higher total score will get a **Prize Money of € 200,- (EURO)**. The winner of the Novice Boys category will also get a **Prize Money of € 200,- (EURO)**. **If a winner is absent at the Award ceremony he or she will not get the Prize Money.**

### **Organization:**

1. The office of the organizing committee and the registration office will be located at the ice rink and will be opened every day during the competition.
2. Participating teams are kindly asked to announce changes to their teams as early as possible but at the latest immediately after the arrival of the team.

### 1. ISU JUDGING SYSTEM NOVICE AND JUNIORS

#### JUNIORS, age and requirements in accordance with I.S.U. - Rules 2008

men: short program (2 min 50 sec) and free skating (4 min)

ladies: short program (2 min 50 sec) and free skating (3 min 30 sec)

#### NOVICE, requirements in accordance with I.S.U. Communication No. 1397 – Guidelines for Novice Competitions

NOVICE GIRLS, born in 1993

NOVICE GIRLS, born in 1994

short program (2 min 50 sec) and free skating (3 min)

NOVICE BOYS, born in 1993/94

short program (2 min 30 sec) and free skating (3 min 30 sec)

#### **Novice: Short Program Singles:**

The Short Program for Girls' Singles shall consist of the following elements:

- a) Axel Paulsen or double Axel Paulsen
- b) Double or triple jump immediately preceded by connecting steps not repeat jump in a)
- c) One jump combination consisting of two double jumps or one double and one triple jump, both jumps may not repeat jump in a) or b)
- d) Layback or sideways leaning spin (minimum of six (6) revolutions)
- e) Spin combination with only one change of foot and at least one change of position (minimum of five (5) revolutions on each foot). The minimum number of revolutions required in a position is two (2). In case this requirement is not fulfilled, the position is not counted
- f) One spiral sequence consisting of at least two (2) spiral positions. Spiral sequence has to be according to the remarks in the ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2008. A spiral position in order to be counted must be held for at least three (3) seconds
- g) One step sequence with full utilization of the ice surface (straight line, circular or serpentine)

The Short Program for Boys' Singles shall consist of the following elements:

- a) Axel Paulsen or double Axel Paulsen
- b) Double or triple jump immediately preceded by connecting steps not repeat jump in a)
- c) One jump combination consisting of two double jumps or one double and one triple jump, both jumps may not repeat jump in a) or b)
- d) Camel or sit spin (minimum of six (6) revolutions). Change of foot is optional. No flying entrance.
- e) Spin combination with only one change of foot and at least one change of position (minimum of five (5) revolutions on each foot). The minimum number of revolutions required in a position is two (2). In case this requirement is not fulfilled, the position is not counted.
- f) Two step sequences of a different nature with full utilization of the ice surface (straight line, serpentine or circular)

#### **Novice: Free Skating Program Singles**

A well balanced Free Skating program for Singles must contain:

- a) Maximum of 6 jump elements for Girls and maximum of 7 jump elements for Boys - one of which must be an Axel type jump and there may be up to three (3) jump combinations or sequences. Only one jump combination can contain three (3) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only two most difficult jumps will be counted. Only two (2) jumps with two and a half (2 1/2) or three (3) revolutions can be repeated either in a jump combination or in a jump sequence.
- b) There must be a maximum of three (3) spins of a different nature, one of which must be a spin combination (minimum of ten (10) revolutions) and one (1) flying spin with no change of position and no change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions). In spins the minimum number of revolutions required in a position is two (2). In case this requirement is not fulfilled, the position is not counted. Number of changes of foot in the spin combination is optional.
- c) There must be a maximum of one (1) step sequence or one (1) spiral sequence consisting of at least two (2) spiral positions for both Boys and Girls. A spiral position in order to be counted must be held for at least 3 seconds.

free skating only: 3 min

CUBS GIRLS, born in 1999 CUBS GIRLS, born in 2000  
free skating only: 2 min

CUBS BOYS, born in 1999/2000  
free skating only: 2 min 30 sec

CHICKS GIRLS, born in 2001 CHICKS GIRLS, born in 2002 or younger  
free skating only: 2 min

CHICKS, BOYS, born in 2001/2002 or younger  
free skating only: 2 min

**The skaters are allowed to compete only in the category available with reference to their birth date (year), except for category Junior. The skaters are not allowed to compete in more than one category.**
